Cross Band Repeaters

Cross band repeating is an effective way to extend the range of your handheld radio. The cross-band repeat function works by using a dual band mobile or base radio to re-transmit on one frequency band a signal received on another frequency band, and vice versa. A common use of the cross band repeat is to extend the range of a handheld radio by using the higher power of your dual band mobile transceiver to hit a distant repeater.
